THE BOUNDARIES OF THE USE OF THE RIGHT OF ASSOCIATION BY ARMED FORCES OF UKRAINE

The article is devoted to the establishment of the appropriateness of the restrictions on the political rights of the Armed Forces of Ukraine to the association in trade unions in the form of obligation to suspend membership in this organization for a period of military service as a means of ensuring the political neutrality of the military service in Ukraine.

The relevance of this topic is due to the fact that today the political rights of military personnel are used subject to the special rules by setting reasonably prescribed limits by rules of administrative law in the sense of anticipation of such a possibility in the Constitution of Ukraine. However, the validity of the establishment does not mean the expediency of the existence of specific legal restrictions on the use of certain rights in a particular historical period.

Despite the fact that the international community is trying to develop uniform rules of social and legal protection of citizens, to unify, to adopt common standards and procedures that would facilitate the recognition of the dignity that is inherent in all members of the human family, the unity of legal regulation of human and civil rights, including political, in different historical periods of the states, and especially when it comes to different countries, cannot be argued.

The purpose of this article is to prove that it is necessary today to review the restrictions set by the political right of the Armed Forces of Ukraine to the association in terms of the feasibility of their existence as the absolute necessity of administrative and legal regulation. In order to achieve the goals, there should be set normative principles of administrative regulation of the prohibition of membership in political parties and trade unions for the period of military service as a restriction of the right to freedom of association, defined the purpose of the existence of restrictions concerning the right to association, established the need for their existence.
