**ON THE ISSUE OF MONETIZATION
OF SOCIAL BENEFITS OF MILITARY SERVICEMEN**

This article is devoted to the question of monetization of privileges of servicemen on the example of the foreign experience of Russia, the USA, and Germany. A detailed analysis of forming compensative payments in the leading countries of the world is conducted. The basic directions of public welfare by means of monetization of social benefits and indemnifications are highlighted in the article.

The purpose of the article is to study the formation of a fundamentally different way to reduce social pressures on military personnel and their families, and change of outdated incentives and compensations for more effective monetary approach, taking into account international experience. The article is an applied research aimed at disclosure of issues in a practical perspective.

The issue of social welfare is considered in the works of such scientists as S.V. Pietkov, P.D. Pylpyenko, N.B. Bolotina, N.V. Artamonov, O.Ye. Kozlov, V.Y. Pashynskiy, O.Yu. Syniavska and others.

The main arguments for the introduction of monetization include: benefits system is a profanation – a part of people use them illegally. However, many benefits are provided only on paper.

We believe that the key to the success of creation of an effective system of social security is to move at the national level to the system of personalized social security of servicemen. Demands of a soldier as a human and citizen usually have a common basis and are secured by the Constitution of Ukraine, namely the right to housing, right to rest, right to health care, right to education, a decent level of remuneration, and so on.
