**ON THE ISSUE OF CONTROL OVER THE EXECUTION OF COMMON MANAGERIAL
DECISIONS BY SUBJECTS OF LAW-ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY**

The issue of control over the implementation of joint management decisions is one of the urgent needs of law enforcement, which is explained as follows: firstly, the current level of development of legal science necessitates theoretical generalization of conceptually domestic and foreign achievements in the study of social and state monitoring and control for law enforcement activities. Secondly, today's existing definitions of "control" and "supervision" in most cases are synonymous and require further clarification. Thirdly, there is no consensus and scientists to determine the elemental composition and phasic control. Fourthly, the need to develop a conceptual framework for the state control in Ukraine updated the absence of the Law "On State Control in Ukraine." Fifthly, the control is an impor-

tant element in the coordination of law enforcement activities at the local level.

This article examines the concept of control as a way to ensure law and discipline in government. The concept, types, and forms of control are determined, the distinction between the concepts of control and supervision is made, and necessary conditions for effective control activities of law enforcement authorities are given.

Thus, under the supervision of the execution of joint management decisions by law enforcement agents at the local level, we understand the diverse forms of verification of a compliance and completeness of joint decisions, determining the results of their implementation, identifying the relevant shortcomings and outlining future tasks of joint law enforcement activities.
