FOREIGN EXPERIENCE IN PROVIDING THE STATE INTERNAL SECURITY BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES AND POSSIBILITIES OF ITS APPLICATION IN UKRAINE

Adverse changes in quality characteristics in the area of internal security are peculiar not only for our country but for almost all countries. In those where the socio-economic and political conditions are prevailing, the importance of effective law enforcement activities on internal security is further improving. Along with solving the task of internal security, law enforcement authorities use specific tools and methods that allow ensuring high performance, efficiency, and end results.

Theoretical problems of improving the internal security of the state by law enforcement agencies are to develop based on a comprehensive analysis the theoretical, methodological, institutional, and legal framework and define the purpose and future trends and prospects for activity on the internal security of Ukraine and ways to improve its provision by law enforcement authorities.

Law enforcement system of Ukraine today is unable to effectively carry out its state functions and tasks in the area of internal security of Ukraine.
