ACTIVITIES OF THE SUBJECTS OF TRANSFER OF GOODS UNDER EXPERT CONTROL

Enterprises that operate in foreign markets with conventional products and comply with legislation have a confidence that entered by them foreign trade agreements (contracts) on the supply of conventional products will not have interference from public authorities during their execution. Most entrepreneurs perceive the use of export control tools to their products as bureaucratic obstacles, which reduces the competitiveness of these products. This view is limited and dangerous.

The purpose of this article is to study characteristics of activities of subjects of transfers of goods in terms of expert control.

Entrepreneurs, who constantly operate in the market, consider export controls as the basis for their solid performance in foreign markets and as a necessary for the interests of the state means of the national and international security. It is because of this, the attitude of entrepreneurs to export control purposes should be responsible.

Thus, the Ukrainian exporters must examine with the foreign importer and end user procedures of such control during actual use of these products by foreign consumers.

Employers need to understand that unauthorized or committed with certain violations of international transfers of military and dual-use goods threaten national interests and international stability, peace and security, so the degree of responsibility for such violations is extremely high.

For the violation of export control legislation, businesses are punished by huge fines, and guilty of this staff is responsible for administrative or criminal penalties.
