ENSURING INDIVIDUAL HUMAN RIGHTS IN MILITIA ACTIVITIES

Human rights are protected by international law and national legislation. Such a legal protection affects each and every aspects of law enforcement. In fact, the constitutional rights and freedoms of man and citizen are the key element of effective law enforcement, as they are required not only respect for human rights in the performance of their duties but also the active protection of said rights. In practice, the consequences of violations of civil, political, economic, human rights by police may be different. The study of this topic is aimed at acquiring a content of rights and freedoms, as well as developing skills to prevent violations of these rights by police officers and ability to provide effective human rights while on duty.

Guarantees of rights and freedoms of man and citizen, as well as the rights and freedoms themselves, depend on the specific conditions of society. In Ukraine, the implementation of proclaimed by the Constitution of Ukraine human rights and freedoms of man and citizen is accompanied by a lot of difficulties and obstacles, leading to deterioration of social relations in many areas of law in the country. In this article, the two groups of reasons for such a situation of ensuring the rights and freedoms of citizens are determined.
