ON THE ISSUE OF PEACEKEEPING POTENTIAL OF UKRAINE

The article is devoted to current trends and prospects of peacekeeping activity of Ukraine in the territory of the CIS and the Black Sea region.

At the present stage, Ukraine is building its national security system in a relatively unstable international environment under conditions of non-participation in defence alliances and countervailing military and political orientations of states of its nearest geographical environment. We emphasize that in the era of globalization, a priority is the provision of sustainable development. The role of military security is reducing in terms of economization of international relations and attempts to implement political influence through military force repeatedly proved their inefficiency.

Due to new approaches to peacemaking role in the system of global security providing, the author set the task to identify the main trends and prospects for peace-making potential of Ukraine in the Black Sea region and the CIS. Thus, in the conditions of the existing peacekeeping potential, the state will receive a numerical superiority in the command structures of operations that will allow realizing national interests in the regions of peacekeeping operations.

A problem of increasing the attractiveness and prestige of military service requires a separate study, which can be achieved primarily by separation and increasing social and legal protection for participants in peacekeeping operations.

The absence of rules on the legal protection of former members of peacekeeping operations in the national law in the future may lead to several negative consequences in the plane of a possible revision of the legitimacy of applying capabilities in peacekeeping operations.

Our country cannot stand aside from the main lines of development of contemporary global processes in the field of security and thus the issue of peacekeeping of Ukraine remains important and such that requires special research in different fields, including law.
